

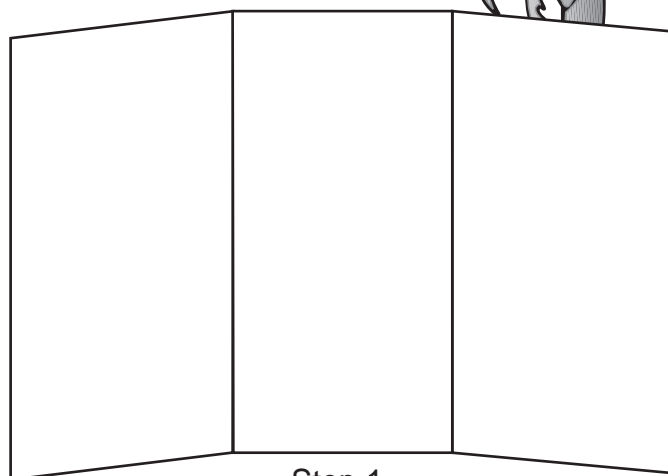
Tri-Fold Insect Reports



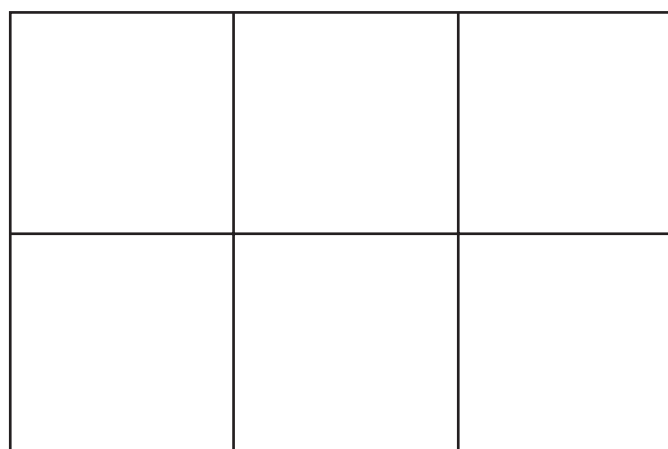
Materials for each student: 12" x 18" sheet of colored construction paper, 3" x 3" sheet of white paper, 1" x 14" strip of colored construction paper, 1/2" x 6" strip of colored construction paper, glue, markers, access to a stapler, tape (optional)

Directions for each student:

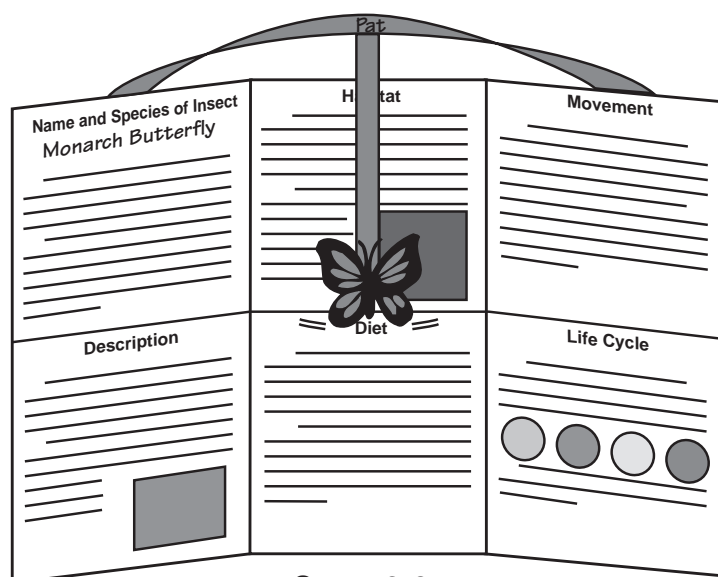
1. Fold the large sheet of paper into thirds widthwise. Use a marker to draw a vertical line through each fold as shown.
2. Next, draw a horizontal line through the middle of the paper as shown to make six boxes.
3. Label the top of each box with one of the six research topics on your "Insect Research Organizer."
4. Use the notes in each section of your organizer to create one or two paragraphs of information for each box.
5. Add pictures, graphs, or illustrations to each box.
6. Write your name on the center of the 1" x 14" strip of paper.
7. Staple the left-hand end of the 1" x 14" strip to the upper left-hand end of the tri-fold; then staple the right-hand end of the 1" x 14" strip to the upper right-hand end of the tri-fold as shown.
8. Staple or tape the 1/2" x 6" strip to the center of the 1" x 14" strip so that it hangs down in the center of the tri-fold as shown.
9. Use markers to draw a picture of your insect on the 3" x 3" piece of white paper. Cut out and staple the illustration to the end of the 1/2" x 6" strip as shown.
